## Who Is This?

*“...I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones  
would immediately cry out.”*

*Luke 19:40*

Imagine standing shoulder to shoulder with onlookers by a dirt  
road. The woman behind you is on her tiptoes, trying to see  
who is coming. In the distance, you glimpse a man riding a  
donkey. As He approaches, people toss their coats onto the  
road. Suddenly, you hear a tree crack behind you.

A man is cutting down palm branches, and people are spreading  
them out ahead of the donkey.
