In 1849, Nathaniel Hawthorne was dismissed from his government job in the customs house. He went home in despair. His wife listened to his tale of woe, set out pen and ink, lit the fire. Then she put her arms around him and said, "Now you will be able to write your novel."

Hawthorne wrote *The Scarlet Letter*.
